



12 Great Reasons to Visit Your Library

1. **Borrow Books** – First and foremost, you can borrow books to your heart's content. Granted, you're only allowed a certain amount at a time, and you do have to return them by the designated date or you'll be socked with a fine, but free book? I'm so there! Going on a long car trip? Borrow some books on tape!
2. **Research** – The library is the absolute best place to conduct research for school papers or writing assignments. Look up laws, zoning regulations, health issues and more.
3. **Study** – The library is quiet and a great place to look up answers to things you may not know.
4. **Buy Books** – Libraries play host to some awesome book sales. Mine often hosts the "Ten for a Dollar Book Drive." Ten paperbacks for a buck? The only thing better than that is free.
5. **Borrow Movies** - Would you believe my husband and I only used our Blockbuster card once? Why should we rent when the library has so many great videos and DVDs? Every weekend I take out two or three movies and we watch together after our son is in bed.
6. **Borrow Music** – I admit, this is a service I don't use often but the library has hundreds of CD's and cassettes for your enjoyment. I have a friend who likes to borrow them for her dinner parties.
7. **Book Discussions** – My library has monthly book discussions. I enjoy getting out for some intelligent conversation with other grownups – and it's all – you guessed it, free!
8. **Kids Stuff** – There's so much stuff for kids to do at the library! Our library offers story time, craft time, sing alongs, teen book talks, summer reading programs, book signings, poetry readings, and so much more.
9. **Internet Access** – Just about every library in America now offers Internet access. My library has about two dozen computers available to patrons. Each can use for about an hour before being booted off. My library also offers wireless. My power went out a lot last month and I took my laptop to the library to work.
10. **Adult Classes** – The library offers so many classes for adults. I've seen GED training, SAT prep, art classes, pottery classes, scrapbooking, pilates and more.
11. **Local Business Promotion** – Many libraries help to promote local businesses. For instance, my own library features local artists' work, or showcases a local business each month.
12. **Socialize** – The library is the place to see and be seen! Every time I go I bump into people I know! But don't chit chat too loud!

- Special programs for children*
- Books on tape/CD for children
- Children's music
- CD roms for children
- Theme bags for children*
- Theme bags for parents and childcare providers*
- Puppets, stuffed animals, puzzles, and other educational toys for children
- Resources for parents and childcare providers*
- Classes for parents and childcare providers*
- Librarians that will go to your childcare center to do storytimes
- Tubs of books that libraries deliver to your childcare center on a regular basis
- Classes you can take to earn continuing education credit
- Educational video programs you can use to earn continuing education credit
- Resource gathering*

What Your Library Can Do For You (For Free!)

- ◆ **Special programs for children:** these may include play groups, puppet shows, activity hours, Read to the Dogs, music programs, etc.
- ◆ **Theme bags for children:** these look different at every library, it is usually a bag that contains 3-4 books, 1 music tape/CD, and 1 educational toy on a particular theme like transportation, going to the doctor, animals, families, first day of preschool, etc. Libraries usually have a series of these available, the bag and its contents check out as if it were one item, and frequently they have developmentally appropriate bags for babies, toddlers, and preschoolers.
- ◆ **Theme bags for parents and childcare providers:** these are like the bags for children, but the bag will contain resources for parents and childcare providers in addition to items for children. This may be a parenting book and an activity guide that provides suggestions for things they can do with their children to enhance their experience with the materials in the bag.
- ◆ **Resources for parents and childcare providers:** this may include parenting books, child development books, programming books, magazines, CD roms, booklists, information on other local play groups or organizations etc. This also includes children's books on issues like potty training, going to the doctor, a death in the family and so forth that are designed for children and adults to read together.
- ◆ **Classes for parents and childcare providers:** this may include baby sign language, how to do developmentally appropriate storytimes, early literacy education, etc.
- ◆ **Resource gathering:** some libraries will gather resources for childcare providers. For example, if you are doing a bug theme at your center you can ask the librarians to pull together resources on bugs for you and your children. They may get things like curriculum planning, children's books, videos, music, CD roms, and activity guides that have to do with bugs for you to check out.

A Framework For Action – What Libraries Can Do to Improve Early Literacy
Oregon Statewide Early Literacy Initiative

Libraries serve an important role in promoting early literacy skills in babies, toddlers, and preschool children. Already, libraries promote these skills through access to books, storytimes, parenting information, knowledgeable staff, and much more. Below are several concrete ways you can encourage children, parents, and caregivers to develop reading and language proficiency in four different areas: Early Literacy Materials/Collections, Atmosphere/Children’s Environments, Programming, and Training & Staff Development.

Some libraries may have more defined early literacy programs than others. You may be starting a program (First Steps) or be improving an already great program (Giant Steps). *Check off the activities that you’re already doing.* Even if you don’t have an early literacy program, you may be surprised by how much you’re already doing to prepare children to read in all three areas. And even if you’ve been working with early literacy for a long time, you may find ideas in First, Next, or Giant Steps that may help you enhance your activities. Regardless as to where you’re at in your program, we hope that this document inspires you to further help the children in your communities.
