# Introduction

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The DUII Data Book for Oregon Counties has been compiled by the staff of the Oregon Department of Transportation, Transportation Safety Division (ODOT-TSD) to assess the severity of Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants (DUII) related problems in Oregon counties.

Crashes involving alcohol and/or other drugs account for nearly half of the fatal and serious injury crashes occurring in Oregon each year. Many of these crashes involve youth that are inexperienced both as drinkers and drivers. Though these problems are not unique to the state of Oregon, Oregonians are taking a “hard line” on alcohol and/or other drug-related fatal and injury traffic crashes.

Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants (DUII) is a complex social problem that has origins in both internal and external system factors. Due to its complexity, Oregon communities and involved agencies must concentrate on addressing the negative reinforcing DUII variables. Chief among these variables are: 1) system deficiencies in dealing with the intoxicated driver, and 2) the public’s knowledge, attitudes and behavior relating to impaired driving.

The DUII Data Book for Oregon Counties seeks to present data compiled from a number of state agency sources that may be used in conjunction with alternative sources, such as attitude and perception surveys, to analyze and identify DUII-related problems. With this information, in addition to input received from involved agencies and groups, it is hoped that specific problems will be identified and targeted for special countermeasure efforts.

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# Using the Data

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The DUII Data Book for Oregon Counties is designed to be used by persons familiar with the DUII control system in Oregon. The information presented in this document is intended to provide comparative data on Oregon counties for assessment of DUII-related problems and countermeasure activities. It can also be useful in obtaining support for county traffic safety programs by providing a comparison of the severity of the major traffic safety problems from county to county and to the state as a whole.

The seven DUII system areas considered are:

- Crashes
- Enforcement Activity
- Implied Consent Suspensions
- Diversion Program
- DUII Convictions
- Additional Court Activity
- Youth Under 21 Years of Age

A series of data tables has been constructed to summarize data representative of the DUII system for each county in Oregon. Use the data cautiously and only after you have reviewed the “Document Citations and Notations” contained in the Appendix. Data from different sources and/or different time periods may not necessarily be comparable.

In some instances, data tables are missing one or two system elements because the data elements were unknown, unreported, not applicable, or not available.

Data can be the basis for a complete analysis of the DUII control system in your county. It can be used to answer such questions as:

- Are fatal and injury crashes increasing or decreasing?
- Is the change significantly different than for other similar sized counties or the state as a whole?

Simple statistical techniques such as normalizing data from two different sized populations and performing chi square analysis can make such analysis more meaningful. Chi square analysis is used to determine if the difference between two different occurrences over time, or between one area or another or two or more different data elements is significant. Other questions might call for relating two or more different kinds of data, such as offenses, arrests and convictions.

You will find that the data will not only help you answer questions about how the DUII system is operating in your county, but will lead you to raise additional questions. It may encourage you to do additional research. If more detailed data is needed, contact either the source cited or Transportation Safety Division staff.

# System Highlights – 2008

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- Fatal and injury traffic crashes decreased from 19,284 crashes in 1999, to 18,409 in 2008. The fatal and injury crash rate for Oregon (crashes per million vehicle miles traveled) has declined from 55.5 in 1999 to 55.0 in 2008.
- Nighttime fatal and injury crashes have increased by 8.1% from 2,519 in 1999 to 2,722 in 2008.
- The percent of fatalities that were determined to be alcohol involved has increased from 39.4% in 1999 to 41.1% in 2008.
- DUII offenses have decreased by 1.1% from 25,091 in 1999 to 24,811 in 2008, while Oregon's population increased 14.8% during the same period.
- DUII arrests for drugs, other than alcohol, have increased 12.0%, from 743 in 1999, to 832 in 2008. This marked increase is due, in part, to the Drug Recognition Expert Program which trains officers to recognize impairment due to intoxicants other than alcohol.
- Breath test refusals increased 2.2%, from 3,100 in 1999 to 3,168 in 2008.
- The number of diversion agreements has decreased by 11.6%, from 12,101 in 1999 to 10,692 in 2008. This represents approximately 43% of the offenses every year.
- DUII convictions are at their highest point in 10 years in 2008 with 10,682 offenders. This is an increase of 5.7% from 10,103 in 1999 to 10,682 in 2008. The percent of convictions that were for a third or subsequent DUII has decreased from 5.7% in 1999 to 3.4% in 2008.
- The number of treatment enrollments for persons convicted of DUII has decreased from 9,827 in 1999 to 8,712 in 2008. In 2005, 99.3% of the enrollments were in rehabilitation treatment programs.
- Fatalities of youth under 21 years of age have decreased significantly from 77 in 1999 to 34 in 2008. There were 9 alcohol related fatalities reported for youth under 21 in 2008.
- Minor in Possession (MIP) citations numbered 14,849 in 1999 and decreased to 7,762 by 2008. In 2008, 718 juveniles were actually denied their license privileges.

## 2. Crashes

### a. Fatal and injury (F&I) crashes

Source: Driver and Motor Vehicle Services, Oregon Department of Transportation, Data Report, Oregon Motor Vehicle Accidents; Crash Analysis and Reporting (CAR), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: The number of motor vehicle crashes that result in a death or injury.

### b. Nighttime (F&I) crashes

Source: Data Report, Oregon Motor Vehicle Accidents; Crash Analysis and Reporting (CAR), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: The number of fatal and injury crashes occurring between the hours of 8 p.m.-4 a.m. Use of crash data occurring 8 p.m.-4 a.m. as a proxy measure for alcohol-involved crashes is generally accepted nationally and suggested by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. This figure has traditionally been used as an indicator of DUI-related problems because of the increased impaired driving activity that usually occurs at night.

### c. Fatalities

Source: Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of deaths resulting from motor vehicle crashes.

### d. Fatalities: Alcohol involved

Source: Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of fatalities resulting from crashes that involve the presence of alcohol or alcohol and other drug-related factors.

### e. Fatalities: Other drug involved

Source: Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of fatalities resulting from crashes that involve the presence of drugs or drugs and alcohol-related factors.

### f. Fatalities: Alcohol only - no drugs involved

Source: Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of fatalities resulting from crashes where alcohol was involved and no other intoxicants.

### g. Fatalities: Both alcohol and drugs involved

Source: Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of fatalities resulting from crashes that involve the presence of both drugs and alcohol-related factors.

### h. Fatalities: Total alcohol involved

Source: Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: The combined total of the number of alcohol only fatalities and those that involve the presence of both drugs and alcohol-related factors.

**i. Fatalities: Other drugs only - no alcohol involved**

Source: Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of fatalities resulting from crashes where drugs were involved and no other intoxicants.

**j. Fatalities: Both alcohol and drugs involved**

Source: Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of fatalities resulting from crashes that involve the presence of both drugs and alcohol-related factors.

**k. Fatalities: Total other drug involved**

Source: Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: The combined total of the number of drug only fatalities and those that involve the presence of both drugs and alcohol-related factors.

**l. Fatalities: Total involved intoxicants**

Source: Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: The combined total of the number of alcohol only fatalities, drug only fatalities, and those that involve the presence of both drugs and alcohol-related factors.

**3. Enforcement Activity**

**a. Total DUII offenses**

Source: DUII Report by County, Law Enforcement Data System.

Explanation: Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants offenses, including juvenile. Arrests are not primarily charged as DUII when in conjunction with a “higher” offense, therefore offenses captures all arrested for DUII.

**b. DUII offenses (drugs other than alcohol)**

Source: DUII Report by County, Law Enforcement Data System.

Explanation: Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants offenses for drugs other than alcohol impaired driving, including juvenile. These figures may vary from the figures provided in the Report of Criminal Offenses and Arrests published annually by the Law Enforcement Data System.

**c. Breath test refused**

Explanation: Total number of persons arrested for DUII who refuse the breath test.

**d. DWS/DWR (misdemeanor) offenses**

Source: Report of Criminal Offenses and Arrests, Law Enforcement Data System.

Explanation: Driving while suspended or revoked misdemeanor arrests recorded by the Law Enforcement Data System for the period indicated. Refer to Oregon Vehicle Code for statutes defining driving while suspended violations, misdemeanors, and felonies.

**e. DWS/DWR (felony) offenses**

Source: Report of Criminal Offenses and Arrests, Law Enforcement Data System.

Explanation: Driving while suspended or revoked felony arrests recorded by the Law Enforcement Data System.

**4. Implied Consent Suspensions**

**a. Suspensions issued**

Source: Implied Consent Suspensions, Driver and Motor Vehicle Services, Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of reports issued by police officers arresting persons for DUII who refuse or fail a breath test and that are received by DMV. (Effective September 29, 1991, the BAC for youth under 21 was lowered to .00.)



**b. Hearings requested**

Source: Implied Consent Suspensions, Driver and Motor Vehicle Services, Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of hearings requested by persons arrested for DUII who want to contest their implied consent suspension. Due to changes in reporting procedures, individual county data is no longer available as of 1990.

**c. Hearings conducted**

Source: Implied Consent Suspensions, Driver and Motor Vehicle Services, Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of hearings regarding implied consent suspensions conducted by DMV. Due to changes in reporting procedures, individual county data is no longer available as of 1990.

**d. Decisions affirming suspensions**

Source: Implied Consent Suspensions, Driver and Motor Vehicle Services, Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of hearing decisions confirming suspensions. Due to changes in reporting procedures, individual county data is no longer available as of 1990.

Explanation: Total number of DWS/DWR misdemeanor convictions posted to driving records during the time period.

**c. DWS/DWR (felony) convictions**

Explanation: Total number of DWS/DWR felony convictions posted to driving records during the time period.

Explanation: Number of fatalities resulting from crashes that involve the presence of alcohol-related factors.

**c. Drug involved fatalities**

Source: Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS), Oregon Department of Transportation.

Explanation: Number of fatalities resulting from crashes that involve the presence of drug-related factors.

**d. DUII arrests**

Source: DUII Offenses by County, Category and Age Groups, Law Enforcement Data System.

Explanation: Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants arrests for youth under age 21.

**e. MIP**

Source: Liquor Law Arrests, by County, Law Enforcement Data System.

Explanation: Minor in possession citations issued to persons 20 years of age or less. In Oregon, the juvenile denial law applies to minors, ages 13-17. Explanation: Number of juveniles experiencing a second, or subsequent denial of their driving privileges.

**9. Alcohol Served**

**a. Sold/served alcohol to VIP**

Source: Oregon Liquor Control Commission.

Explanation: Number of violations in Oregon for selling or serving alcohol to a visibly intoxicated person (VIP). [ORS 471.315(1)(a)(G)]

**b. Allowed VIP to consume**

Source: Oregon Liquor Control Commission.

Explanation: Number of violations in Oregon for making liquor available to a visibly intoxicated person.

**c. Failed to verify age/check ID of minor (or sale)**

Source: Oregon Liquor Control Commission.

Explanation: Number of violations in Oregon for failing to check identification (minor buying or consuming).
