Author Matt Love's latest book about Oregon, *Love & The Green Lady: Meditations on the Yaquina Bay Bridge, Oregon's Crown Jewel of Socialism* blends an eclectic variety of literary genres, including memoir, essay, vignette, autobiography, letter, homework, meditation, coffee table book, ode, commentary, oral history, polemic, curriculum, and confession. It also features over 100 photographs, many taken by Love's photography students at Newport High School where he teaches English, Journalism and Photography.

In his presentation, Love will discuss his book, its unique nonfiction approach, last fall's 75th anniversary of the Yaquina Bay Bridge and bridge designer Conde McCullough's contribution to Oregon. He'll also present a slide show illustrating his rewarding experience of teaching photography in an era when elective arts classes are being phased out because of budget cuts and testing mandates.
